

For riggers at CFB Trenton, it's de rigueur.

The annual Air and Aviation Logistics Support Company Rigger Rodeo is a chance for parachute riggers to pit their skills against fellow riggers and the clock.

While a race against the clock, packing a chute must be done right. No matter how fast it is done, the chute must still open when required or the exercise is worthless.

"I will be sure - always," is the way the Rigger's Pledge ends and riggers only pack as fast as they can be sure it is being done right.

But some of them can pack a parachute pretty quickly.

In the initial CT-1 competition, Cpl Jonathon Marcoux packed his chute in eight minutes and 43 seconds.

Ironically, Marcoux had also been used just moments earlier to demonstrate the packing of the final CT-1 parachute - a traditional static-line deployed round parachute - to be delivered to the Canadian Forces Land Advanced Warfare

Centre (CFLAWC) Friday. The venerable Canadian Troops 1 was the first Canadian-designed, manufactured and utilized parachute which featured the parachute skirt modification, which eliminated partial malfunctions.

This year's Rigger Rodeo was held in conjunction with the retirement of the CT-1, according to Master Warrant Officer Martin "Diezel" Lodder, a rigger with CFLAWC since 1982 who has logged over 1,500 jumps.

"We don't even know what the new chute is yet," he told a gaggle of reporters at the rodeo. "It will have a slower descent rate, though."

Cost to replace the parachute is \$35 million and MWO Lodder and the other riggers are hoping to know which chute will replace the CT-1 by next summer. The Canadian Forces hopes to replace all its parachutes from 2013 to 2019.

"By mid-year next year, we'll be down to 1,700 CT-1s," Lodder told the media. "That's at critical point."

Museum volunteer service pins distributed Final phase of museum construction to be completed in 2013

A very large number of volunteers came out to the National Air Force Museum of Canada Dec. 11 for the museum's Volunteer Appreciation luncheon.

After the volunteers were treated to a catered lunch and their service pins were distributed – pins for periods of time representing one year to 28 years – Executive Director of the museum Chris Colton took the opportunity to update the volunteers on the future plans for the historical facility.



Replacement of the tried and true CT-1 will take some time, according to MWO Lodder. Evaluation of the entries to replace the CT-1 must be completed and trend analysis must be established, although the CF will likely use the United States Air Force numbers for much of that analysis as they complete approximately 150,000 jumps per year.

He also expects the new chute to fall closely within the CT-1 parameters in some respects, so all of the equipment used to pack the chutes does not also have to be changed and increase the cost exponentially.

When that new chute comes into use, expect the packing rates for the riggers to slow down initially until they get enough packs done to create some muscle memory.


On Friday, though, there was plenty of muscle memory on display.

Cpl Marcoux won the first CT-1 packing competition and was defeated in the CR-1 (reserve chute) competition by Cpl Rob Rose. However, Marcoux's combined times were better than Cpl Rose's, giving Cpl Marcoux the overall win. Cpl Rose placed second and Cpl Joseph Stalteri placed third.

In the second competition, packing the CT-6 main and reserve parachutes on the floor, Cpl Marcoux again came through with the best combined time followed by Pte Ian Malenfant and Cpl Rose.


"The competition/ceremony went extremely well," said Cpl Julio Tartaglia, the man who organized this year's competition.

"These events strengthen our relationship with the public, and with our fellow riggers. It's not very often we have the opportunity to demonstrate to the public the 'safety and perfection' going into the packing of every parachute," he told The Contact.

Go slow when shoveling snow

You wake up one morning to the heaviest snowfall of the season. You have to shovel the car out of the driveway.

When you arrive for the early shift, no one has even cleared the snow away from the plant entrance, so you reach for a shovel again, even though your back is hurting and you feel slightly dizzy. What should you do if moving to southern California is not an option?

Stop and think before you tackle these heavy jobs. Studies have shown shoveling snow can be as rough on you as a maximum-speed workout on a treadmill.

Every year people die of heart attacks when they over-exert themselves while clearing snow. Back injuries and strained muscles are also common injuries from this task. For those who are out of shape or already have heart problems, the combination of heavy work and cold temperatures can bring on a heart attack. Here are some tips for safer snow shoveling:

- Get your doctor's okay for snow shoveling before you attempt it if you know you are out of shape or have a history of heart trouble.
- Dress in layers so you can shed some clothing if you get too warm.
- Don't rush into the job. Start slowly to give your body a chance to warm up.
- You may be tempted to shovel quickly until the job is done so you can return to the comforts of indoors. Instead, work at a slow pace.
- Stretch every few minutes and take breaks every 15 minutes or so. Drink water on your breaks to replace fluids lost through sweating.
- If the snow is deep or heavy with moisture, scoop some off the top and then go back for a second load.
- Maybe you don't have to do all the shoveling in one day. If the snowfall is moderate, you may be able to tackle half the driveway one day and the other half the next.
- Use safe lifting techniques for snow shoveling. Bend your knees, not your back. Lift the shovel by straightening your legs.
- Keep your feet apart to improve your balance.
- Keep the load close to your body.
- Do not twist your body to toss the snow aside. Turn by moving your feet, and toss straight ahead.
- Choose the right kind of shovel for the job. While steel shovels are sturdy, they are also heavy. Aluminum and plastic models are lighter but less durable. To remove powdery snow, you can push a large shovel shaped like a plow. Wet snow requires a shovel designed for lifting.
- For the safety of passersby, never leave a snow shovel where it can become a tripping hazard.

If you must shovel snow, do so safely. Remember the risks, and take your time!




