Task Force Canuck completes mission in Kandahar, journeys across Asia for friendly visit

In a dusky twilight at Kandahar Airfield (KAF) on Nov. 16, airmen and airwomen of Task Force Canuck proudly stood on parade in front of the CC-130 J Hercules aircraft as they completed their mission of transporting Canadian Forces personnel and equipment in and out of KAF and throughout Afghanistan in support of the International Security Assistance Force (ISAF).

"The departure from Kandahar of the last remaining CC-130 Hercules aircraft after 10 years of continuous service in support of coalition forces in Afghanistan is a monumental milestone in Canadian Air Mobility Operations, as it marks the close-out of the longest continuous Tactical Airlift operation in the Royal Canadian Air Force history," said Colonel Sean Friday,

Commander 8 Wing.

The CC-130J Hercules, flown by 436 Transport Squadron (Sqn), departed Kandahar early in the morning of Nov. 17 and flew to India to pay tribute to 436 Sqn's historical roots.

"India was where 436 Squadron was formed as a Tactical Air Transport unit and where it conducted its first operational missions as an RCAF squadron," said Lieutenant-Colonel Colin Keiver, Commanding Officer 436 Sqn. "It is fitting that it returns from its most recent and significant mission through the place where it began 67 years ago."

During the visit, RCAF personnel met with their counterparts in the Indian Air Force for an enriching cultural exchange. Also, the visit allowed Canadian airmen and airwomen to pay tribute in





Soldier On Celebrity Golf Tournament June 12, 2012

Organizers of the Soldier On Celebrity Golf Tournament at Roundel Glenn Golf Course scheduled for June 12, 2012 say it will be bigger and better than ever, especially if they get the kind of military participation they expect.

John Casey, the organizer and publicist behind the event, made that statement at the presentation of a \$15,000 Soldier On cheque, the funds raised from last year's event, at CFB Trenton Tuesday morning.

Casey is determined to make the 6th annual coming event the best yet, which was why he was appealing for participation by everyone, but especially the military.

"We would like to get more military personnel out and we want to get the SAR Techs back in the air," Casey said after the cheque presentation.

He promised that military foursomes would be like all other foursomes in the Soldier On Celebrity Golf Tournament. "We'll give you your own pet celebrity for

the day," he said.

Those celebrities include greats like former Maple Leafs goaltender Johnny Bower, comedian Colin Mochrie, Canadian Idol winner Ryan Malcolm and former Maple Leaf Bob Neely, plus many, many more.

The reason for the Soldier On tournament still exists, he stated. "The wounded are still here and they still need the funds," provided by Soldier On.

Of the four segments of a successful tournament, Casey states two are never a problem.

"We have fantastic sponsors and the celebrities always step up," he told the media and military personnel gathered at the event.

Sponsors like Tim Horton's in Trenton, Spotlight Limousine, Snap-on Tools and Season's Retirement Centre in Trenton are the main sponsors, although Casey is quick to add they can always use more sponsors.

But for the tournament to really take off, Casey says the Canadian public and the military really need to come

to the table and get involved.

The tournament has raised over \$100,000 in the five years it has been organized, raising \$20,000 the first year. Even with the success of the past, Casey and everyone involved with the tournament want to do more. He wants to bring in 40 celebrities and have 144 golfers and raise just an obscene amount of money for this cause.

People like Master Corporal Jody Mitic and Sergeant Andrew McLean are examples of why everyone should do their utmost to assist this cause, Casey indicates. He calls Mitic "the poster boy for Soldier On" and he recalls Sgt McLean running when nobody knew he was running, all to raise awareness of the trials and tribulations of rehabilitating wounded military personnel. Mitic, a sniper from CFB Petawawa, lost both legs when he stepped on a landmine.

"It's the least we can do," Casey notes. "So go out and tell everyone the tournament takes place on June 12. We want everyone to take part and get involved."

Heritage preservation at CFS Alert


Dr. Georgiana Stanciu from the National Air Force Museum of Canada and Maj Brenda Tucker from 8 Wing Trenton paid a visit to CFS Alert on Nov. 15. Their objective was to conduct an inventory and evaluation of historical artefacts that are kept at the station. Over the years, CFS Alert has accumulated an interesting collection of artefacts related to Arctic history.

Part of this collection includes items coming from the first explorer that came to the region during the 19th century, such as a wooden sign from HMS Resolute. HMS Resolute was part of the Belcher Expedition held in the Arctic in 1852-53. HMS Resolute is also well known to have provided the timbers that were later used to construct the famous

"Resolute desk", which is the President of the United States' desk in the Oval Office.

Among other items, the station has one of the most cherished first book editions of "Shores of the Polar Sea" written in 1878 by Dr. Edward L. Moss of HMS Alert. This book is a narrative of the British Arctic Expedition, led by Sir George Strong Nares in 1875-76. Two ships were part of that expedition, HMS Alert and HMS Discovery. HMS Alert (our station's namesake) was a 17-gun wooden cruiser of the Royal Navy which reached Cape Sheridan in 1876, located at latitude 82°N on Ellesmere Island, which was a record at that time and is just south of CFS Alert's location.

Former Para Rescue sergeant's parachute on display in museum where he volunteers

Former Para Rescue Sgt (Ret) Kenneth (Pinky) Hogg is a compact but still fit man who does not suffer fools lightly.

Retired since 1981 from Para Rescue - or Search and Rescue as it is now called - Hogg put in a second 28-year career with the Commissionaires. Were it not for a back that gives him almost constant pain and sore legs, he looks like he could still don a parachute and be ready to jump today.

But jumping out of perfectly serviceable aircraft is not part of his agenda anymore. Now, to get himself out of the house, he volunteers on Thursdays at the NAFMC in Trenton, which features as one of its displays the very same parachute Hogg used at the end of his Para Rescue career. You know it's his parachute because his name is on it.

Hogg spent most of his military career in western Canada, serving on bases in Edmonton, Winnipeg and Comox before finally retiring in Trenton.

When asked about his most memorable or exciting jump, Hogg looks at the reporter and finally decides to confide in him.

"The weirdest one I was ever on was probably my last operational jump in British Columbia," he states.

With a little more coaxing, he tells the story after getting a promise not to publish all the details of the episode.

The flight starts with a man flying a notoriously unreliable aircraft through the mountains with another man's wife as his passenger. Hogg says the man should have been the last one to be taking off with another man's wife, but that's the part of the story he doesn't want the reporter dwelling on.

After lifting off, the pilot takes the small aircraft up to 17,000 feet, where he begins to run into two problems - icing and a lack of oxygen. High above cloud cover, it is hard to know which of his problems will bring him down first until he spots a hole in the clouds and descends quickly through it.

Luckily, this pilot spots a runway in the middle of the mountains and manages to drop his aircraft onto it without doing damage to the aircraft or its passengers.

But now he was out of gas.

Para Rescue was informed of the aircraft disappearing and was sent out to look for it, although the aircraft's ETL signal was bouncing off the mountains and was very unreliable. Fortunately for the couple, a bush pilot flying over spotted the aircraft and dropped in to see that everything was copacetic. Upon finding out they were out of gas, he took off, retrieved some gas and got it transferred into the aircraft, filling it.

It was about this time that the Para Rescue flight also located them.

Hogg describes the situation as it was about to unfold.

"They're on this tiny little runway barely wide enough to hold the undercarriage of an aircraft and the runway slopes upward. He's at the bottom and about to take off on the up-slope with a big mountain at that end. We finally talk him into taxiing up to the upper

end and taking off downhill."

The reporter can't help but notice Hogg shaking his head and hear the muttering under his breath, although he does not record those mutterings for fear he couldn't use them anyway.

"He starts his run down the runway and finally goes to pull up," Hogg reports with more shaking of the head and mumbling. "Because he has such a heavy load of fuel on, he ends up crashing into a field of boulders at the end of the runway," all of which has been observed from above by the Para Rescue aircraft and its passengers.

While Hogg doesn't actually say this, we're pretty sure he did some more shaking of his head and mumbling at this point, as he and his partner prepared to jump down to help.

Did we mention that Hogg is very light? His partner, a much bigger and

Tips to help you safely deck your halls



Klutzy comedians having accidents while decorating for the holidays is a stale joke. In real life, it's not funny if you fall or start a fire. However,

you and your family can spruce up the house safely by following some guidelines.

Safety checklist before the holidays

- Put any fuel that can catch on fire in a safe container outside the home.
- Test your home's multipurpose fire extinguisher.
- Test the batteries in your fire alarm.
- Clear any clutter out of escape routes from your home.
- If toddlers will be visiting, install safety gates at tops and bottoms of stairs.
- Check your throw rugs for non-slip backings.

- Put nightlights in hallways.
- To prevent fall hazards, install window guards with emergency release mechanisms on high windows.
- Test the ground fault circuit interrupters (GFCIs), both indoors and outdoors.

Tree trimming

- Before you buy a live tree, bend some needles in half. If they break easily or don't spring back, the tree is too dry.
- At home, put your tree in a non-tip stand kept filled with water.
- Place it at least three feet (one meter) away from a heat source, and near an electrical outlet.
- Never put candles on a tree.
- Before you string on the lights, inspect the bulbs, sockets and cords for damage.

heavier man, managed to hit the runway within the valley, but Hogg is being held up by an updraft. He finally makes a hard landing with his legs well spread – right over a boulder.

Unhurt other than perhaps contributing to the pain in his back and knees later in life, Hogg sheds his parachute and joins his partner at the crashed aircraft after getting soaked trying to cross a creek. (Anyone want to bet there was more shaking of the head and muttering at this point.)

They immediately determine that a deadhead has crashed through the windshield of the aircraft, directly between its two occupants. The woman is virtually unscathed, but the pilot has a broken wrist and a broken nose.

Hogg is somewhat incredulous when he looks into the back of the aircraft and finds it filled with religious material. Not a man to filter his thoughts, he says, "Does that stuff make good eating when you're lost?"

Not a man to rely on detail too much, Hogg indicates they finally got the couple into an aircraft and got out of the valley, with Hogg helping the pilot read the map rather than sit in the back with the man responsible for the rescue effort. Perhaps he was afraid he wouldn't be able to keep his feelings down to a shaking of the head and mumbling any longer. His partner took care of the passengers.

"Normally a rescue like that would

get lots of publicity," he said, "but there was absolutely none about that incident," he notes, looking the reporter directly in the eye.

Retired from the military for many years now, Hogg admits to still missing the esprit de corps and the comradeship of many of the people he worked with. He said he really enjoyed working with the Hercules crews at 436 Squadron.

Why is Hogg's parachute now in the museum? Two reasons, actually. Hogg wasn't one of those people to put his life in the hands of others, so he packed and rigged his own parachute to his liking. While it was a standard issue parachute, he rigged it slightly differently from most others and felt he got better results from it, both on rescue missions and in competitive jumps. Eventually, after others "borrowed" it now and again, he was encouraged to put his name in silk lettering on the "lobster tail" of the chute.

Hogg enjoys the day at the museum, stating, "I've met some very interesting people there."

Like so many of the volunteers at the museum, Hogg is also very interesting and full of great stories. When you do your next tour of the NAFMC, make sure you ask a few questions of those volunteers showing you around. Their stories are often at least as interesting as whatever they might be telling you about the museum and getting their spin on it is priceless, especially if you're not some fool reporter.

The new chief clerk, LS Gagnon, came from Shearwater, Nova Scotia.


"I've always wanted to come here," said LS Gagnon. "I didn't know what to expect, but I am pretty sure it would be a unique experience."

Wing Logistics and Engineering Picture of the Week

Patrons of the MFRC will have noticed by now a lot of new construction activity around the building. This is Phase 1 of a multi-phase renovation project, carried out by 8 Wing Construction Engineering (WCE). The 81 CEF (Construction Engineering Flight) and the CE (Construction Engineering) shops are working together to enhance the services offered by our local MFRC. On Monday, Oct. 17, the concrete footings were poured for a new storage addition, when complete items currently stored in a room across from the Teen Center will be moved in. The room that will then be vacated will be renovated and turned over to the Teen Center for their use. The addition itself will be constructed of similar block so that it ties in with the existing structure. Masons from WCE will assist 81 CEF Construction Techs with the block installation, giving our apprentice tradesmen experience in this form of construction.

A concurrent Phase 2 project will see the new construction of a sun shelter located between the new pool and the basketball court. When it is completed, it will be large enough to accommodate a full size picnic table as well as providing much needed shade in the summer. Using the latest in building materials, techniques and design, the structure will last for many years to come. Ground breaking is set for sometime soon. As with all construction sites, we ask that visitors respect that hazards exist and to stay out of fenced areas for their own safety as well as others. We will keep you informed as we proceed, to eventually start working inside the MFRC itself.

a solemn ceremony of remembrance to the 15 RCAF veterans, who are interred at the Delhi War Cemetery. Delegations from 435 and 436 Squadrons, both formed in India during WW II in support of the China-Burma-India theatre, were in attendance as well as Canada's High Commissioner, representation from other defence staffs, and the Indian Air Force.

On its way back home, the CC-130J Hercules aircraft, crew and passengers stopped in Malaysia, Indonesia, Brunei, and the Philippines to meet with their air force counterparts in the region to help further boost the existing vibrant relations between our forces.

"We have dynamic and vibrant relations in Southeast Asia with the Association of Southeast Asian Nations," said Colonel Michel Latouche, Canada's Defence Attaché

in Southeast Asia. "Canada welcomed this opportunity to have a Canadian aircraft visit in order to demonstrate its commitment to enhancing our cordial relations with the region."

Canada's relations with Malaysia, Indonesia, Brunei, and the Philippines have a long history of engaging in the promotion and protection of human rights, democracy, governance and pluralism. Counter-terrorism cooperation and capacity building is another key pillar of the bilateral relationship with those countries as well as their participation in Canada's Military Training Cooperation Program (MTCP).

The team is expected to arrive at CFB Trenton on Nov. 30 after its journey across the world.

"We take pride in having served in Kandahar and are truly honoured to be the first in the Royal Canadian Air Force to fly the CC-130J around the globe," said LCol Keiver.

"We encourage the community to come out and celebrate the season by enjoying the sights and sounds of the Holiday Train", notes Jaelyn Grimmon, the City's Manager of Recreation and Tourism Services.

The exterior of this spacious side-by-side duplex features numerous details that lend it an air of elegance, including gables, stone-based pilasters and partly mullioned windows.

Inside, the roomy foyer contains a coat closet. 
